

ESAVS OFFICE FOR ASIA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The European School for Advanced Veterinary Studies Asia (ESAVS Office for Asia) offers financial support to encourage veterinarians with limited financial means, access to the top-level training.

Particular emphasis is put on providing the opportunity to participate in this course to gifted veterinarians with genuine financial needs.

The scholarship consists of a 100 Euro per person financial support for course registration. The stipend is a reduction of the registration fee. Delegates are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses.

The following selection criteria need to be addressed in the scholarship application:

1. Proof of veterinary qualification
2. Curriculum vitae/resume
3. Proof of limited financial means / low income
4. Evidence of interest and commitment to high level clinical veterinary science
5. The name of your veterinary praxis or clinic, place of work
6. Letter of recommendation, preferably but not exclusively by a former ESAVS course participant
7. Proof of adequate ability to speak and write in English

Selection Procedure: A Selection Committee is appointed by the ESAVS Office for Asia Board for awarding the scholarships.
